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Steps:

1. Submit the Application to the Arizona Sports Concussion Center (email, fax).
2. Print a copy of the SB 1521 Concussion Legislative Summary from the ASCC website. Ensure your Concussion Program is prominent on your website (Home Page link) as well as hard copies are provided to parents/athletes.
3. Your Policies and Programs will be compared to the Arizona Interscholastic Association Forms 15.7-A, 15.7-B, and 15.7-C. Copies of those forms may be obtained from aiaonline.org and are on the ASCC site. This is considered the minimal acceptable standard.
4. Payment for the Compliance Review is required prior to final Certification. You will be notified of your fee via email after submitting the application.
5. You will meet (in person or via the phone) with ASCC personnel to review your Concussion Program as it relates to SB1521.
6. Certificates will be awarded based on meeting Gold, Silver or Bronze standards.(see information).
7. After Certification, your organization must provide the ASCC hard copies of all elements of your "Concussion Program", including website page copies.
8. Your organization assumes full responsibility and liability for collecting all signed "Statement and Acknowledgment Forms" for your parents/players.
9. The Compliance Certificate is good for one Calendar year, and must be renewed annually.
10. We will provide you as many Compliance Certificates as you need for your School District contracts. We will also provide copies of your Program to the School Districts should it be required.
